

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO REQUIRING EVERY PERSON AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE CITY OF BONIFAY TO USE GARBAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM AS PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained and enacted by the City Council of the City of Bonifay of the County of Holmes, State of Florida:

1. That from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance all persons and every business establishment within the City of Bonifay shall be required to use the garbage disposal system provided by the City. The fact that persons occupying premises as residences, or that business is conducted upon premises shall be prima facie evidence that garbage and trash is being accumulated.

2. Should any person violate the provisions of this Ordinance they shall be punished as heretofore provided in Ordinance Number 118 of the City of Bonifay, Florida, relating to garbage collection.

3. Should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue to be in full force and effect.


4. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in so far as the same affect this Ordinance.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval.
