

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 177

An Ordinance amending Section 9 of Chapter 8920 Laws of Florida 1921 known as the charter for the City of Bonifay by deleting the words, "the term of the mayor being one year" and substituting the words, "the term of the mayor being two years beginning the second Tuesday in March, 1978": and providing that the governing body of the municipality shall place the proposed amendment to a vote of the electors at the next general election to be held within the municipality on the second Tuesday in March, 1977; and repealing all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION:

SECTION 1: That Section 9 of Chapter 8920 Laws of Florida 1921 known as the charter for the City of Bonifay be amended by deleting the words, "the term of the mayor being one year" and substituting the words, "the term of the mayor being two years beginning the second Tuesday in March, 1978."

SECTION 2: That this proposed amendment be submitted to the electors of said municipality for their approval or disapproval by a majority vote at the next general election of said municipality to be held on the second Tuesday in March, 1977.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in force at the time this Ordinance is adopted shall remain in force except those which are specifically known to be in conflict with this Ordinance shall be hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
