

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 198

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE BANNING OF TRAILERS, MOBILE HOMES AND ANY TEMPORARY STRUCTURES ALONG STATE HIGHWAY 79 WITHIN 100 FEET OF THE RIGHT OF WAY FROM NORTH BONIFAY CITY LIMITS TO SOUTH BONIFAY CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to place or construct a mobile home, trailer or similiar temporary structure within 100 feet of the right of way on State Road 79 from the north Bonifay city limits to South Bonifay city limits.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall knowingly or wilfully violate Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be punished by fines not to exceed \$25.00 and not less than \$10.00 per day during the period of said violation. These fines to be paid to the City Clerk and entered into the register and deposted into the City Treasury.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its' passage and approval but is not retroactive.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 198
BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING SECTION WHICH
WILL ALLOW THE CITY OF BONIFAY TO GRANT
A VARIANCE AND TO CONTROL PERMITTING.

SECTION 1. This amendment is an addition to an existing ordinance regulating placement of temporary structures.


SECTION 2. All other provisions in the previous ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The City of Bonifay reserves the right to grant a variance on an individual basis and reserves the right to revoke permission of any permit granted by giving 90 days advance written notice to vacate the premises as described in the permit.

SECTION 4. This amendment does not pertain to residential areas.

DONE AND PASSED THIS 8th DAY OF AUGUST, 1994 by majority vote of the City Council of the City of Bonifay, Florida.
