

ORDINANCE # 250

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
THE USAGE AND REMOVAL OF
POLITICAL CAMPAIGN AD-
VERTISEMENTS REQUIRING
DEPOSIT AND PENALTIES.

IT IS HEREBY ordained as follows:

1. Each candidate, whether for a Federal, State, County or City Office, shall make a good faith effort to remove from City Streets, City Property, State or County Road right of way, political advertisements within thirty days after:

- (a) Withdraw of his candidacy.
- (b) Having been eliminated as a candidate.
- (c) Being elected to office.

2. Each candidate whether Federal, State, County or City shall deposit \$250.00 (TWO HUNDRED & FIFTY DOLLARS) with the City Clerk upon qualifying for his respective office. The \$250.00 shall be returned upon the removal of all political campaign advertisements as specified herein. However, if the political campaign advertisements are not removed within the specified time, the political candidate who failed to remove said signs shall forfeit his \$250.00 to the City and may be required to pay an additional sum for the removal of said signs by the City.

3. No political campaign advertisements shall be placed on a City building or on the property where a City building is located or in the City Cemetery, or in any other location which will create a traffic hazard, no matter where situated.

4. The Holmes County Supervisor of Elections shall notify each political candidate of this ordinance before said candidate qualifies.

5. Any candidate placing political campaign advertisements on properties described herein without making the \$250.00 deposit with the City Clerk shall be subject to a fine of \$250.00 and their signs shall be removed.

6. This ordinance shall become effective by its passage.
