

ORDINANCE #283

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING PEDDLERS  
WITHIN THE CITY OF BONIFAY  
AND  
APPLICATION PROCEDURE WITH PENALTIES

The City Council of the City of Bonifay does ordain as follow:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, agency, corporation or business entity to peddle goods from a pack, cart, vehicle, from any other means and/or to peddle services without a permit from the City of Bonifay.

2. Peddlers are among those people who are going from place to place to sell certain lawful goods from a pack, a cart, a vehicle or from any other means and/or from peddling services within the corporate limits of the City of Bonifay.

3. No one under the age of 18 years will be issued a peddler's license.

4. All solicitations for schools or charitable organizations are exempt hereunder.


5. All other persons or entities described herein shall make application with the City of Bonifay to obtain a permit to peddle goods or services.

6. Any person, agency, corporation, or business entity guilty of violation of this Ordinance shall be charged with a misdemeanor third degree with a fine not to exceed five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).


7. This ordinance shall take effect from, on, and after the date of its passage, posting and publication.

8. There shall be a 24 hour waiting period .
