Separate Sealed Bids for: CDBG DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION project will be received by the CITY OF BONIFAY at 301 J Harvey Etheridge Street Bonifay, FL 32425 until 2:00 PM CST time on Wednesday, December 7th, 2022. The project is being sponsored by the City of Bonifay and consists of constructing 3,800 square-foot 1-story commercial building. The project scope includes building construction and site work. Project duration is 210 days for substantial completion and 30 days for final completion. Contractors bidding on the project shall be licensed General Contractors in the State of Florida and shall have a minimum 5-years of experience constructing commercial buildings of similar nature.

The project is located in Bonifay, FL just northwest of the SR 79 and E Pennsylvania Avenue intersection. All Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked "SEALED BID: CITY OF BONIFAY – CDBG DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION." All Bids received will be PUBLICLY opened and read. The bid will be awarded at the next scheduled Council Meeting

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. A Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the Bid shall accompany the Bid. The City of Bonifay (City) reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any formalities, and award in the best interest of the City of Bonifay. All Bids shall be firm for a period of 90 days after opening. This includes material prices. The bid must conform to Section 287.133(3) Florida Statutes, on public entity crimes.
