

ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE WHICH DELETES AND VACATES ORDINANCE NO. 120 WHICH GRANTS GULF POWER COMPANY AN ELECTRICAL FRANCHISE IN THE CITY OF BONIFAY, AND THE HOLDINGS OF A REFERENDUM AND FURTHER NULLIFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 25694 LAWS OF FLORIDA, ACT OF 1949 WHICH REQUIRES A REFERENDUM FOR AN ELECTRICAL FRANCHISE.

SECTION 1. The City of Bonifay hereby vacates Ordinance No. 120 and all provision therein and further nullifies all referendum requirements of Chapter 25694, Laws of Florida, Act of 1949.

The City hereby declares an election shall not be required on the granting of an Electrical Franchise to Gulf Power Company.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption on February 13, 1984.
