

ORDINANCE # 210

AN ORDINANCE WHICH AMENDS EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 196 WHICH REQUIRED THE REDUCTION OF THE 10% RATES FOR ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE, GAS AND OTHER UTILITIES TO A 9% RATE. THE AMENDMENT WILL RESTORE THE PREVIOUS 10% RATE TO UTILITY COMPANIES.

WHEREAS the City was advised to reduce its 10% tax rates for electric, telephone and gas to 9% for the period from October 1, 1982 through September 30th, 1983 and

WHEREAS the City by ordinance No. 196 reduced said rates for the period of time which satisfied the requirements of House Bill 2-D and

WHEREAS the city is no longer required to have said reduced utility rates IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the City the following:


SECTION 1. That emergency ordinance No. 196 is amended whereby the City shall have a 10% utility tax rate for gas, electric and telephone

SECTION 2. That the City declares it has complied with Ordinance No. 196 and all utilities shall pay a 10% tax rate.


