#### ORDINANCE # 224

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING AND INCREASING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, COUNTY OF HOLMES, STATE OF FLORIDA PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF FLORIDA STATUTES 171.044 ANNEXATION OF PROCEDURES BY ANNEXING THERETO CERTAIN TRACTS OF LAND CONTIGUOUS AND COMPACT AND NOT EMBRACED WITHIN THE PRESENT LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY.

# Proposed Annexed Area

Beginning at Pt. on North line of R.R. R/W 97 feet West of dividing line between Northeast \( \frac{1}{4} \) of Southwest \( \frac{1}{4} \) and Northwest \( \frac{1}{4} \) of Southeast \( \frac{1}{4} \) and run West 718 feet, North 576 feet East 759 feet South 676 feet to Point of Beginning. Also begin at Northeast Corner of Southwest \( \frac{1}{4} \) and run West 47 feet, South 625 \( 5/12 \) feet East 157 feet, North 629 \( 8/12 \) feet, West 103 feet to Point of Beginning. Also begin at Southeast Corner of Northwest \( \frac{1}{4} \) thence run North 88 degrees 03 minutes 34 seconds West along the South line of said Northwest \( \frac{1}{4} \) 787.90 feet, thence North 01 degree 10 minutes 55 seconds West 202.08 feet; thence South 87 degrees 55 minutes 32 seconds East 898.62 feet; thence South 0 degrees 25 minutes 35 seconds West 200.0 feet; thence North 88 degrees 03 minutes 34 seconds West 105.0 feet to Point of Beginning in Section 36, Township 5 North, Range 15 West, in Holmes County, Florida.and \( \frac{1}{2} \) of NW% of SW% LESS 10.4 Ac. for I-10. LESS a parcel Des. in OR 55/639.

The City Council of City of Bonifay does ordain as follows:

## SECTION ONE

The City Council hereby determines that the territory described does meet the criteria of Florida Statutes, and that such described territory is contiguous to the present City boundaries and compact and not embraced within the city limits; and therefore the City Council of the City of Bonifay has jurisdiction to annex the territory described herein.

## SECTION TWO

The City of Bonifay shall extend and provide all its urban services existing or which may be provided in the future to the area described in Section Four hereof. The urban services shall be provided on the same basis as now existing within the city limits and in the same manner of the City prior to annexation.

#### SECTION THREE

If any provisions of this ordinance shall be held invalid, its invality shall not affect any other provisions of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and for this purpose the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

#### SECTION FOUR

The corporate limits of the City of Bonifay are hereby extended and increased so as to include and embrace within the corporate limits of the City of Bonifay the following described territory and such city territory is hereby annexed and declared to be a part of the City of Bonifay.

# THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY IS THE AREA TO BE ANNEXED

Beginning at Pt. on North line of R.R. R/W 97 feet West of dividing line between Northeast \$\frac{1}{4}\$ of Southwest \$\frac{1}{4}\$ and Northwest \$\frac{1}{4}\$ of Southeast \$\frac{1}{4}\$ and run West 718 feet, North 576 feet East 759 feet South 676 feet to Point of Beginning. Also begin at Northeast Corner of Southwest \$\frac{1}{4}\$ and run West 47 feet, South 625 5/12 feet East 157 feet, North 629 8/12 feet, West 103 feet to Point of Beginning. Also begin at Southeast Corner of Northwest \$\frac{1}{4}\$ thence run North 88 degrees 03 minutes 34 seconds West along the South line of said Northwest \$\frac{1}{4}\$ 787.90 feet, thence North 01 degree 10 minutes 55 seconds West 202.08 feet; thence South 87 degrees 55 minutes 32 seconds East 898.62 feet; thence South 0 degrees 25 minutes 35 seconds West 200.0 feet; thence North 88 degrees 03 minutes 34 seconds West 105.0 feet to Point of Beginning in Section 36, Township 5 North, Range 15 West, in Holmes County, Florida.and \$\frac{1}{2}\$ of NW% of SW% LESS 10.4 Ac. for I-10. LESS a parcel Des. in OR 55/639.
