

ORDINANCE # 260

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 8920, LAW OF FLORIDA 1921. AMENDING THAT PORTION OF SAID CHARTER PERTAINING TO THE OFFICE OF MAYOR WHICH INCLUDES ELECTING A MAYOR PURSUANT TO SECTION 9 OF SAID CHARTER AND POWER AND DUTIES OF SAID MAYOR PURSUANT TO SECTION 24 AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR A DATE FOR TERMINATION OF THE OFFICE OF MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the CITY has decided to put before the electors the issue of whether the City should or should not abolish the office of Mayor.

IT IS HEREBY RESOVLED

That there will be submitted to the voters of the City of Bonifay the following question. Shall the City of Bonifay have a Mayor elected by the electors as now established under the Charter of the City of Bonifay, Section 9, and Section 24 hereof?

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED

That a special election should be held for the amendment of the Bonifay City Charter pertaining to the office of Mayor. All qualified electors shall be eligible to vote on the Amendment of said Charter at the Bonifay City Hall between the hours of 7:00AM and 7:00PM. on the 31st JULY, 1990.

IT IS RESOLVED

That the Notice of Special Election shall read as follows:

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that a special election shall be held for the Amendment of the City of Bonifay Charter Section 9 and 24 hereof. Allqualified electors shall be eligible to vote at the City Hall of Bonifay, Florida between the hours of 7:00AM and 7:00PM on JULY 31st, 1990 for the question of shall the City of Bonifay have a

Mayor elected by the electors as now established
under the Charter of the City of Bonifay, Section
9 and 24 hereof.

If a voter votes YES, it shall mean the termination of the Office
effective March 1992
of Mayor/and a NO vote shall mean the Office of Mayor shall remain
an elected office subject to powers and restrictions of said 1921
Charter and the Laws of the State of Florida.
