

ORDINANCE # 262

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CHARGES BY THE CITY OF BONIFAY FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF CONNECTING TO ITS WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM AND FURTHER SPECIFYING THE AMOUNT OF CHARGES

SECTION 1. Any new water or sewer customer who connects to water and or sewer in the City of Bonifay shall be required to pay a fee for said privilege.

SECTION 2. The purpose of the fee is to defray the costs of production, distribution, transmission and treatment facilities for water and sewer. These fees are in addition to charges imposed for the costs of physically connecting to the water and sewer system.

SECTION 3. However, these charges in this Ordinance are only applicable to those desiring to connect in the future and does not pertain to existing water and sewer customers. Existing water and sewer customers does not mean, those who intend to relocate a business within the jurisdiction of the City.

SECTION 4. For commercial users which is anyone other than a residential home, the City will charge a fee not in excess of 25% of water and sewer gross revenues generated by the City. A subdivision shall be classified commercial. The City may grant a variance to some commercial users based upon the amount of water and sewer consumption used, but it shall not exceed 4.5%.
