CITY OF BONIFAY. FLORIDA ORDINANCE NO. 375

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA; THIS ORDINANCE IS TO PLACE A PROPOSED AMENDMENT REPEALING ANY PREVIOUS CITY CHARTER AMENDMENT ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION OF A CHIEF OF POLICE TO THE CITY CHARTER TO A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS AT THE NEXT ANNUAL CITY ELECTION AS PER THE CITY CHARTER SECTION 6.06A.

WHEREAS, the City of Bonifay, Florida (hereinafter referred to as the "City") wishes to amend the City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA THAT:

That any and all amendments to the City Charter establishing the election of a Chief of Police be repealed and that all references to Chief of Police be those placed in the City Charter in January 1991 by the citizens of the City of Bonifay.

That the effective date of this proposed amendment shall be one minute past the next annual election date.

That this proposed amendment shall supersede any amendment offered at the same annual election on the subject of Elected Chief of Police.

That this proposed amendment will be titled "Repeal Amendment that calls for an elected Police Chief."
