ORDINANCE NUMBER 87

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH RATES FOR SALE OF ELECTRIC SERVICE TO THE INHABITANTS OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, BY HOUSTON POWER COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the rates schedules attached hereto and herrinafter set out and designated service Classifications:

" HA", "HD", "HI", "HH", AND "HJ".

re hereby approved by the City Council as being the rates for which electric service shall be urnished to the inhabitants of the City of Bonifay, Florida by Houston Power Company, its uccessors or assigns.

Section 2. The rates hereinabove set out shall remain in force until such time as any of hem may be changed by agreement between the City of Bonifay, Florida and Houston Power Comany, its successors or assigns, or until changed by the action of some regulatory body duly uthorized thereto under the laws of the State of Florida.

Section 3. The said Houston Power Company its successors and assigns shall, within ninety 90) days from approval of this ordinance by the Mayor file a written acceptance hereof with the Clerk of said City.

HOUSTON POWER COMPANY, SERVICE CLASSIFICATION "HA", RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL LIGHTING,

AVALIABILITY

Available for general lighting purposes to any customer, served by the transmission system over the retail distribution lines of the Company in urban cantors,

RATE

- 10 cents per KWH for the first 30 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 8 cents per KWH for the next 170 KWH consumed fper month; plus
- 7 cents per KWH for the next 300 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 6 cents per KWH for the next 350 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 5 cents per KWH for the next 850 KWH consumed per month; plus.

'inimum

In consideration of the readiness of the Campany to furnish such service, a monthly minimum of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) will be charged.

Parment

The current monthly bill is subject to an additional of ten (10) per cent provided the account is not paid in full within ten days from date of bill.

Deposit

A deposit of \$2.50 or more if deemed advisable, shall be required of each customer before ervice is connected at premises designated, which deposit may be applied to any unpaid bills gainst the customer for service or material.

HOUSTON POWER COMPANY, SERVICE CLASSIFICATION "HD" COOKING AND HEATING.

110-220 VOLTS TRANSMISSION SYSTEM.

Availability

Available for electric cooking, air heating, water heating and incidential uses having a ombined rating of not less than 2 kW, when served by the transmission system over the retail disribution lines of the Company in urban centers. Lighting load not in excess of cooking or heating load will be connected on same meter for service to residences, individual apartments and rivate offices only. This schedule is not available for rectifiers, X-ray apparatus and motors in excess of 1 kW rating, nor for lighting except as stated.

RITE

#3.00 Per month for the first 7 KW, or fraction thereof, of connected load entitling the ustomer for this payment use during the month, 30 kilowatt hours of electric energy; plus 1.00 per month for each KW, or fraction thereof, of connected load in excess of 7 KW, entitling he Customer for this payment to use during the month 15 kilowatt hours of electric energy for ach KW in excess of 7 KW; plus 3 1/2 cents per KWh for the next 150 KWH consumed per month; plus 1/2 cents per KWH for the energy consumed per month in excess of the above stated amounts.

DETERMINATION OF CONNECTED LOAD

The connected load shall be taken as the sum of the individual ratings of all stoves, ranges, teaters and miscellaneous appliances which are so connected that they can be operated simultaneously, but shall not include domestic household appliances designed for socket combination. All appliances will be considered as simultaneously operated unless connected on a double-throw witch; in which case only the greatest total rating of those appliances which can be operated at the same time will be considered in determining the connected load.

MUMINIM

In consideration of the readiness of the company to furnish such service, the following nonthly minimum will be charged; \$3.00 per month for the first 7 KW of fraction thereof, of connected load; plus \$1.00 per month for each KW, or fraction thereof, of connected load in excess of 7 KW.

PAYMENT

The current monthly bill is subject to an addition of ten (10) percent provided the account is not paid in full within ten days from date of bill.

Deposit

A deposit of ten dollars (\$10.00) or more if deemed advisable, shall be required of each Customer before service is connected at premises designated, which deposit may be applied to any unpaid bills against the customer for service or material.

HOUSTON POWER COMPANY, SERVICE CLASSIFICATION "HH" A. C. SMALL PUWER. 440-220-110-VOLTS TRANSMISSION SYSTEM.

AVAILABILITY

Available for all power purposes to any Customer requiring a capacity of less than 100 ilowatts, when served from the transmission sustem of the Company.

DELIVERY VOLTAGE

The delivery voltage to the Customer shall be determined by the voltage of the available ocal distribution lines of the Company and the standard voltage of the secondaries of its ransformers for the locality in which the service is to be rendered, but the Company shall not e required to deliver service at a voltage of less than approximately 110 nor more than approximately 440 Volts.

RATE

Demand Charge; \$2.00 per month per KW of demand, entitling the Customer for this payment o use during the month 20 KWH of energy; plus Energy Charge; for KWH in excess of that inluded above;

- 3.0 cents per KH for the next 1,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 2.0 cents per KHH for the next 4,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 1.00 cents per KWH for the next 15,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- .9 cents per KWH for all over 20,000 KWH consumed per month; plus.

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

The demand shall be determined at the option of the Company by inspection or by test, but n no case shall it be for less than one (1) kilowatt. (1) By inspection the kilowatt demand hall be taken as follows;

70% of the rating in HP of the largest capacity motor; plus

55% of the rating in HP of the next largest capacity motor; plus

40% of the rating in HP of sll other motors; plus

100% of the KW rating of all power apparatus other than motors. (2) By test, the maxnum integrated fifteen minute load at any time. The demand billed shall be the demand as deermined by one of the above methods, but not less than the greastest demand established during
ny of the eleven preceeding months, for less than the capacity required to be maintained.

PAYMENT

The current monthly bill is subject to an addition of five (5) percent provided the account s not paid in full within ten days from the date of the bill.

MINIMUM BITL

In consideration of the readiness of the Company to furnish such service, a monthly inimum equal to the demand charge will be charged, and in no case will the minimum be for less nan one (1) kilowatt.

TERM OF CONTRACT.

Service under this classification shall be for a period of one or more years and thereafter rom year to year until terminated by three (3) months written notice by either party to the other.

HOUSTON POWER COMPANY, SERVICE CLASSIFICATION "HI" INTERMEDIATE POWER., 13000-6600-4000-2400-600-VOLTS, TRANSMISSION SYSTEM.

AVAILABILITY

Available for all power purposes to any Customer requiring a Capacity of 100 kilowatts or more, when served from the transmission system of the Company.

DELIVERY VOLTAGE

The delivery voltage to the Customer shall be determined by the voltage of the available local distribution lines of the Company and the standard voltage of the secondaries of its transformers for the locality in which the service is to be rendered, but the company shall not be required to deliver service at a voltage of less than approximately 600 nor more than approximately 13, 200 volts.

Rate

Demand Charge; \$2.00 per month per KW of demand, entitling the Customer for this payment to use during the month 40 KWH of energy: plus

Energy Charge: for KWH in excess of that included above;

- 3.0 cents per KWH for the next 1,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 2.0 cents per KWH for the next 4,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 1.0 cents per KWH for the next 15,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- 19 cents per KWH for the next 30,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- -8 cents per KWH for the next 50,000 KWH consumed per month; plus

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

The kilowatt demand shall be based on the Customer's maximum integrated fifteen minute demand during each service month, provided such demand shall not be less than the demand established during any of the eleven preceeding months and in no case shall such demand be less than the capacity required to be maintained.

PAYMENT

The current monthly bill is subject to an addition of five (5) percent provided the account is not paid in full within ten days from date of bill.

MINIMUM BILL

In consideration of the readiness of the Company to furnish such service; the monthly minimum equal to the demand charge will be charged, and in no case will the minimum be for less than one hundred (100) kilowatts.

TERMS OF CONTRACT

Service under this classification shall be for a period of one or more years, and thereafter from year to year until terminated by six (6) months written notice by either party to the other. HOUSTON POWER COMPANY, SERVICE CLASSIFICATION "HJ" A.C. HIGH TENSION POWER 110000-44000-2000 Volts Transmission system.

AVAILABILITY

Available for all power purposes to any Customer requiring a capacity or 500 kilowatts or ore, when served from the transmission system of the Company.

DELIVERY VOLTAGE

The delivery voltage to the Customer shall be determined by the voltage of the available ransmission lines of the Company and the standard voltage of the secondaries of its transformers for the locality in which the service is to be rendered, but the Company shall not be required to deliver service at a voltage of less than approximately 22,000 volts.

RATE

Demand Charge; \$2.00 per month per KW of demand, entitling the Customer for this payment, to use during the month 60 KWH of energy; plus energy charge for KWH in excess of that included above 3.0 cents per KWH for thenext 1,000 KWH consumed per month; plus

- 2.0 cents per KWH for the next 4,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- L.O cents per KWH for the next 15,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- .9 cents per KWH for the next 30,000 KWH consumed per month; plus
- .8 cents per KWH for thenext 50,000 KWH consumed per month; plus.

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

The kilowatt demand shall be based on the Customer's maximum integrated fifteen minute demand luring each service month, provided such demand shall not be less than the demand established luring any of the eleven preceeding months and in no case shall such demand be less than the capacity required to be maintained.

PAYMENT

The current monthly bill is subject to an addition of five (5) percent provided the account is not paid in full within ten days from the date of bill.

MINIMUM BILL

In consideration of the readiness of the Company to furnish such service, a monthly minimum equal to the demand charge will be charged, and in no case will the minimum be for less than five hundred (500) kilowatts.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Service under this classification shall be for a period of one or more years, and thereafter from year to year, until terminated by six (6) month, written notice by either party to the other.
