

ORDINANCE NUMBER 90

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC UPON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, AND TO PROVIDE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to drive any automobile, wagon or other vehicle to drivers left of the center of any street within the said City of Bonifay, Florida.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive any automobile or other motor vehicle upon the streets of the City of Bonifay, Florida, after night fall without therebeing burning upon said automobile or other motor vehicle at least one good white front light and one red rear light.

Section 3. That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive upon the streets or any of the streets of the City of Bonifay, Florida at a rate of speed greater than is then and there reasonable and proper.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating any one or all of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by fine not exceeding \$25.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.


