ORDINANCE NUMBER 96

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING LICENSE AND OTHER TAXES, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THERE OF, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR DOING BUBINESS WITHOUT A LICENSE, OR OTHER FAILURE TRO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR, AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA.

Section 1. No person, firm or coroporation in the City of Bonifay, Florida shall engage in or manage the business, profession or occupation mentioned im this ordinance unless a City License shall have been procured from the City Clerk, which amount hereinafter provided, and to which shall be affixed the seal of the City of Bonifay, Florida and shall entitle such person, form or corporation to engage in the business, profession or occuption named therein, every word importing the singular number in this ordinance shall be construted and extended to apply to the plural and every word in quoting the plural number may be constructed and extended to apply to the singular number, and every word in quoting the mascline gender only may be construed and extended to and applied to females as well as males.

Section 2. No license shall be issued for a longer period than one year, and all license shall expire on the last day of October each year, but fractional license may be issued to expire on that date at an appropriate rate, provided that no license shall be issued for less than half of the amount hereafter provided as their license for one year.

Section 3. All licenses shall be due and payable in advance before the first day of November of each year, and no license shall be issued for any fractional part of a year except that any license not otherwise specified in this ordinance may be issued after the first day of may to expire the last day of October, upon payment of one half of the amount fixed as the price of such licenses for one year.

Section 4. The following enumerated individual license taxes shall be paid in the City of Bonifay, Florida, by the person, firm or corporations engaging in managing or transating, within the corporate pimits of the City of Bonifay, Florida the following occupations, business or professions for which a license is required under the laws of Florida, to-wit:

Section 41. Bonding companies, guarantee and security companues or persons, firm or corporations engaged in the business of making bonds for profit, per year or fractional part thereof, \$5.00.

Section 42. BOOK AGENTS OR CANVASSERS, for the sale of books, maps, periodicales stationery and the like, or selling or delivering the same, per year or fractional part thereof, \$10.00.

Section 43. Boot Black stands outside of barbe shops for each chair contained therein, per year \$2.00.

Section 44. Boot, and shoe makers or repairers when operated by hand, per year \$2.50, when ope ated by electric or other power, per year \$5.00.

Section 45. Boot, and shoe dealers, (see merchandise).

Section 46. Bottling works, either manufactured in the City or delive ed by truck or otherwise, per year \$15.00.

Section 204. Typewritters, repairs, per year \$2.50.

Section 205. Undertakers, per year \$12.50.

Section 206. Upholsters, of furniture or cars, per year, \$5.00.

Section 207. Vulcanizers, and Vulcanizing establishments, exclusive of other license, per year, \$5.00.

Section 208. Vending machines when operated for profit, per year \$5.00.

Section 209. Watch and Jewlery repaires and Gold-smith, per year \$5.00.

Section 210. Wood-yards, or persons selling wood or charocal, per year \$2.50.

Section 194. Soda water Fountains additional to other licenses, per year, \$5.00.

Section 193. Skating Rinks, Itinerant, per week, \$25.00, Skating Rink run in permanent building, per year, \$25.00.

Section 211. Weighing Machines, per year, \$5.00.

Section 212. The revenue from all licenses, imposed by this Ordinance shall go to the General Funds, of the City of Bonifay, Flarida.

Section 213. Every person, firm or corporation having a license shall exhibit the same when called upon to do so by any authorized officer of the city, and all licenses must be conspicuously displayed at all times.

Section 214. Any person or persons, firm coporation of association that shall carry on or conduct any business or profession of which a licanse is required by this Ordinance without first obtained such license, shall be guilty and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not more than double the amount required for such license, the payment of all license tax shall be enforced by seizure and sale of the property by the Chief of police and it is hereby made the duty of the Chief of Police to report to the Mayor and Board of Councilmen any Violation of this ordinance.

Section 215. Every City license shall be frunished by the City Clark under the City Corporate Seal under his hand upon blanks furnished by the City Councilmen, and the persons obtaining such license shall keep such license conspiciously exhibited at their place of business, and upon failure to do so shall be subjected to pay another amount and take out another licenses for the business conducted.

Section 216. Any person or persons firm or corporation or association delinquent for more than thirty (30) days from November, 1st in the payment of a license shall berequired to pay a penalty of fifty (50) percent of the amount of such license, and any person or persons form or corporation or association engaging in or carrying on any business within the City of Bonifay, Florida, for more than sixty (60) days without procuring a license required shall be deemed and held guilty of a misdeamor and upon conviction shall be fined not exceeding thirty(30) days.

Section 217. All Ordinances and parts of the Ørdinances in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repeaked.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effedt immediately after its passage by the board of Councilmen and approval by the Mayor.
