ORDINANCE NUMBER 102

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING AND LEVYING AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX UPON ALL PERSONS FIRMS OR CORPORATIONS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF MANUFACTURING, SELLING BARTERING OR EXCHANGEING OR IN ANY WISE DEALING IN OR CAUSING, OR BEING CONCERNED IN THE MANFAC_ TURE, SALE BARTER OR EXCHANGE OF ANY MALT OR VINOUBE BEVERAFES COMMONLY KNOWN AS BEER PORTER, ALE WINE, OR FRUIT JUICES CONTAINING MORE THAN ONE HALF OF ONE PERCENT OF ALCOHOL AS ARE NOT PROHIBITED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA: MAKING IT A PENALTY TO SO ENGAGE IN SUCH BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF BONIFAY WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING A LICENSE AND PRESCRIBING A PWNALTY FOR THE BIOLATION OF THOS ORDINANCE.

EE IT OR DAINED EY THE CITY COUNCIL, AND THE MAYOR, OF THE CITY OF BONIFAY, FLORIDA, Section 1. All persons, firms, associations of persons, or corporations engaging, in the City of Bonifay, Florida, in the business of manfacturing, selling bartering or exchanging or in anywise dealing in or causing, or being concerned in the manfacturing sale, bater or exchange of any malt or vinous beverages, commonly known as beer, porter, ale, wine or fruit juices containing more than one half of percent, of alcoholic and as are not prohibited by the laws of the State of Florida are hereby assessed and required to pay occupational license tax for the privilege of so engaging in said business corporation so engaging in said business, in the City of Bonifay, without first having paid the license tax and abtained a license as hereinafter provided, shall be deemed and held guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon convicitén shall be fined not exceeding fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment at hard labor upon the streets of Bonifay, not exceeding Sixty Days, or punished by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 2. Any person, association of persons, or corporation desiring to pay the required tax and to pay license to engage in the business of manufacturing, selling, bartering or exchange malt or vinous berverages as provided for in section 1, of this ordinance shall file with the Tax Collector of the City fo Bonifay, a written or printed application for a license to conduct auch business which may be a duplicate of theapp-lication required by the State of Florida, or one containing substantially the same information, upon receipt of such application and the license tax herein provided, and proof that State and County license to such applicant to conduct such business within the City of Bonifay.

Section 3. The licenses herein provided for shall be classified as following:

(a) Manufacturers, who shall be licensed to conduct the business of manufacturing the beverages referred to and distrubiting or selling the same at holesale to either the distributors or vendors. (b) Distributors, who shall, when sold license, be permitted to distribute the berverages herein referred to and wholesale to vendors but who may not sell any such beverages at retail to be consumed on their premises.

(c) Vendors, who shall include all persons, association of persons or corporations, selling beverages herein feferred to, as retail and such terms shall embrace hotels, restaurants, clubs, stores, boats, dinning cats, and all other licensed to sell said beverages at retail.

Section 4. There is hereby assessed and levied and occupational license tax on all manufactures, distributors and vendors of malt, or vinous beverages, referred to in Section 1, of this oridnance as follows:

(1) Each Manufacturer shall pay a license fee of three hundred seventy five dollars (\$375.00) per annum for each manufacturing plant or establishment he may operate in the City of Bonifay provided however, that manufacturing engaged exclusively in the production and processing of fruit juices, shall pay a license fee of One Hundered Twenty Five Dollars (\$125.00) per annum.

(2) Each distributors or wholesale dealers shall pay a license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per annum for each and every wholesale establishment.

(3) Each Vendor, shall pay an annual license as follows:

(a)	Resturants and Eating places	\$
	Accomddating less than 15 persons,	10.00
	Accomodating 15 to 59 persons,	17.50
	Accomodating 50 to 99 persons,	37.50
	Accomodating 100 persons or more,	50.00
(b)	Hotels	\$10.00
	Less than 30 rooms,	10.00
	30 to 99 rooms,	17.00
	100 to 299 rooms,	37.50
	300rooms, or more	50.00

Where a hotel or resturant or dinning room are jointly operated only one license fee shall be paid and that shall be the higest fee applicable to either the hotel or resturant.

Dinning Cars and other passenger carries vending the beverages herein defined shall be classified as resturants.

(c) Stores, shops or similar places of business shall pay a license of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50).

Clubs or association of persons whether incorporated or not incorporated for profit or not, for profit, shall of they have hotel rooms or their equivalent or having dinning facilities or both, shall pay the highest tate applicable to either hotel or restaurant, shall only pay one license fee, provided that clubs shall pay a minimum license fee of Twelve Dollars and fifty Cents (\$12.50), if they have no hotel rooms or dinning facilities. Section 5. The license fees provided for in this Ordinance shall be collected by the City Tax Collector and deposited in the General Funds of the City.

Section 6. No license issued under this ordinance shall transferred, all license shall be issued for the period from January first to December the Thirty First of the galendar yeat in which the dame shall be issued. Providing, however, that any person who shall be required to pay a license tax hereunder begining business and applying for a license after the first day of July of any year shall pay only one galf of the annual license tax, provided herein. Provided, however, where said business was subject to license prior to July 1st, no shch fractionaly rate shall be allowed.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that the same may be in conflict with the progisions of this ordinance and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council and by the approval of the Mayor.
